IMPORTANT NOTICE ON NEW RESTRICTIONS RELATED TO NOVEL CORONAVIRUS

(The Entry Ban for Foreigners from Designated Countries Including Bosnia and Herzegovina Extended until the End of June 2020)

- 1. Based on designated Bosnia and Herzegovina as a target area for denied permission to land in Japan on the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act of Japan, foreigners who have stayed in Bosnia and Herzegovina within the last 14 days will not be permitted to land in Japan unless there are special circumstances from 0:00 am on 3 April 2020 (Japanese Time) until the last day of June 2020. The period can be renewed.
- 2. Visa applications will be accepted only when there are special circumstances (Diplomatic and Official visa, Spouse of Japanese national etc.). Visa applicants are required to fill in and submit a special questionnaire.
- 3. All nationals (both foreigners and Japanese) arriving from Bosnia and Herzegovina are subjected to the PCR test and to be requested to stay at a location designated by the quarantine station chief for 14 days and to refrain from using public transportation in Japan.
